



MID-SOMERSET CARNIVALS 2009 – affecting bus services in the Weston-super-Mare & Wells areas

BRIDGWATER (Friday 6 November)

Service 375 WELLS to BRIDGWATER

The 1804 from Wells to Bridgwater and 1928 from Bridgwater to Wells will operate between Puriton and Bridgwater direct via the A38 and Wylds Road and will not serve Bath Road or Knowle Hall.

Service 21 BURNHAM-on-SEA to TAUNTON

All buses will run but after 1800, they will go via the M5 from Huntworth to Dunball then Bristol Road and Wylds Road to the Bus Station.

Town services in Bridgwater are also diverted. Please ask for this information at the Travel Shop.

BURNHAM-ON-SEA (Monday 9 November)

Service 102 WESTON-super-MARE to PURITON

Love Lane in Burnham-on-Sea is closed so until 1740, journeys will operate non-stop between the Edithmead roundabout and Manor Road via the A38 to Highbridge then Burnham Road, Highbridge Road and Oxford Street. School journeys from East Brent to King Alfred School are not affected.

The 1745 from Weston to Puriton will operate as normal to the Edithmead roundabout then direct via the A38 to Highbridge then resume normal route to Puriton. It will not serve Burnham-on-Sea.

The 1904 from Puriton to Weston will operate as normal to East Huntspill then direct via Watchfield, Pillmore Lane, Burnham Moor Lane and A38 to Whitecross (Brent Street) then resume normal route from there to Weston. It will not serve New Road, Highbridge or Burnham-on-Sea.

Service 112 WESTON-super-MARE to HIGHBRIDGE

The 1810, 1910 & 2110 from Weston to Highbridge will operate to Burnham-on-Sea (Sea View Road) only and not serve Pier Street or Highbridge. The 1915, 2015 & 2220 from Highbridge to Weston will start instead from Burnham-on-Sea (Sea View Road) at 1926, 2026 & 2231 respectively and not serve Highbridge or Pier Street. The 2210 from Weston to Highbridge will operate normal route.

Service 21 and 21A BURNHAM-on-SEA to TAUNTON: – these services will terminate at Highbridge

GLASTONBURY (Saturday 14 November)

One-way system (13-15 November)

There will be a one-way clockwise loop in operation in Glastonbury town centre from 1800 onwards on Friday 13 November until 1200 on Sunday 15 November except when the Carnival is in progress when this is superseded by the diversions below. Southbound buses will go via Lambrook Street & Bere Lane with 29 & 375-7 continuing via Fishers Hill. All these services will stop at the Somerset Rural Life Museum in Bere Lane and not serve the centre of Glastonbury. Northbound services are not affected.

Other changes on Saturday 14 November

Service 29 WELLS to TAUNTON, Service 375 WELLS to BRIDGWATER and Service 377 WELLS to YEOVIL

The (29) 1735 & 1845 from Wells to Taunton and 1720 & 1805 from Taunton to Wells, the (375) 1804 from Wells to Bridgwater and 1609, 1709, 1819 & 1928 from Bridgwater to Wells, the (377) 1714, 1918 & 2049 from Wells to Yeovil and the 1636, 1736, 1905 & 2035 from Yeovil to Wells – all these journeys will run normally in the sections Wells to Glastonbury (Tin Bridge Roundabout) and again from Street (Crispin Hall/Library) to Taunton/Bridgwater/Yeovil. Between these sections, they will divert via Wick, Bere Lane, Butleigh Road and South Moor. The stop for Glastonbury will be at the Somerset Rural Life Museum in Bere Lane. They will not be able to serve Windmill Hill, the centre of Glastonbury or Northover.

Service 376 BRISTOL & WELLS to STREET

The 1540, 1610, 1640, 1710, 1920, 2020 & 2120 from Bristol to Street and the 1735, 1835, 1857, 2047, 2147 & 2247 from Street to Wells/Bristol will run normally in the sections Wells to Glastonbury (Tin Bridge Roundabout) but then diverted via Wick, Bere Lane, Butleigh Road and South Moor. The stop for Glastonbury will be at the Somerset Rural Life Museum in Bere Lane. They will not be able to serve Windmill Hill, the centre of Glastonbury or Northover.

The 1540, 1610 & 1640 from Bristol to Street and the 1735 & 1835 from Street to Bristol will then operate to and from Oakfield Road as usual.

However, the 1710, 1920, 2020 & 2120 from Bristol to Street will then terminate at Street (Library) and not continue to Oakfield Road. Also, the 1857, 2047, 2147 & 2247 from Street to Wells/Bristol will start from Street (Crispin Hall) instead 7 minutes earlier than usual and not start from Oakfield Road.

MIDSOMER NORTON (Thursday 12 November)

Service 173 BATH to WELLS

The 1905 from Bath to Wells will operate as normal to Radstock then via Somervale Road, Radstock Road, North Road, Church Lane and Redfield Road then normal route from there to Wells. A temporary stop will be in place on Church Lane near the garage during the closure.

Service 178/778 BATH to BRISTOL, Service 184 BATH to FROME

Between 1900 and 2200, journeys will be diverted between Midsomer Norton and Radstock via Redfield Road, Church Lane, North Road, Radstock Road and Somervale Road and vice versa. Temporary stops will be in place on Church Lane near the garage during the closure.

NORTH PETHERTON (Saturday 7 November)

Service 21 and Service 21A BURNHAM-on-SEA to TAUNTON

These are diverted via the M5 between Taunton and Bridgwater.

SHEPTON MALLET (Wednesday 11 November)

Service 161 FROME to WELLS

The 1755 from Wells to Frome and 1755 & 1911 from Frome to Wells will operate normal route except between Wells (The Liberty) and Shepton Mallet (Charlton Inn) when it diverts via the B3139, Burnt Wood crossroads, the B3135 and A37. They will not serve the centre of Shepton Mallet nor Croscombe, Dinder and Dulcote. The 1820 from Wells to Shepton Mallet and 1848 from Shepton Mallet to Wells will run normally between Wells and Bowlsh (Horseshoe Pub) then operate direct via St Peters Road to Shepton Community Hospital. These will not serve the centre of Shepton Mallet. The 1920, 2020, 2120 & 2320 from Wells to Shepton Mallet and 1948, 2048, 2148 & 2342 from Shepton Mallet to Wells will not operate. This is because the A371 is closed from 1930.

WELLS (Friday 13 November)

The Bus Station will be closed from 1800 and not re-open until Saturday morning. Instead, buses will operate from a temporary terminus at a bus stop in Portway between the Wookey Hole Road and Strawberry Way North junctions.

Service 29 WELLS to TAUNTON,

Service 375 WELLS to BRIDGWATER and Service 377 WELLS to YEOVIL

The (29) 1845 from Wells to Taunton and 1720 & 1805 from Taunton to Wells, the (375) 1804 from Wells to Bridgwater and 1643, 1709, 1819 & 1928 from Bridgwater to Wells, the (377) 1918 & 2049 from Wells to Yeovil and 1736, 1905, 2035 & 2235 from Yeovil to Wells – all these journeys will start and finish in Wells at the temporary terminus. From Portway, they will divert via Coronation Road and Jocelyn Drive to Glastonbury Road then normal route to Glastonbury, Street and Taunton/Bridgwater/Yeovil.

Service 126 WELLS to WESTON-super-MARE

The 1845, 2035 & 2217 from Wells to Weston and 1705, 1805, 2000, 2150 & 2330 from Weston to Wells will all start and finish in Wells at the temporary terminus.

Service 161 WELLS to SHEPTON MALLET & FROME

The 1820, 1920, 2020, 2120 & 2320 from Wells to Shepton Mallet, the 1755 & 1911 from Frome to Wells and 1746, 1848, 1948, 2048, 2148 & 2342 from Shepton Mallet to Wells will all start and finish in Wells at the temporary terminus, operating to The Liberty then normal route to Shepton Mallet.

Service 173 BATH to WELLS

The 1705, 1805 & 1905 from Bath to Wells will operate normal route to Burnt Wood crossroads then via Green Ore and Bristol Hill to Wells then divert via Portway to finish at the temporary terminus. They will not go via South Horrington.

Service 376 BRISTOL & WELLS to STREET

The 1655, 1725, 1800, 1830, 1920, 2020, 2120, 2220 & 2320 from Bristol to Wells/Street and 1735, 1835, 1857, 2047, 2147, 2247 & 2347 from Street to Wells/Bristol will operate normal route between Bristol and Green Ore then via Bristol Hill and Portway to the temporary terminus. They will not go via South Horrington. From Portway, they will divert via Coronation Road and Jocelyn Drive to Glastonbury Road then normal route to Glastonbury and Street.
