

From 25 October 2009 we will be making changes to the way our **FirstDay**, **FirstWeek** and **2-Journey** range of discounted travel tickets will operate.

From this date, a new zonal structure will be used to determine the area of validity and the price paid for these tickets. This handy guide has been designed to explain the changes so that you continue to pick the ticket that is right for you. Please note that these changes do not affect our FirstCard customers.

What changes are being made?

- New zone-based areas of validity introduced
- Revised prices for some ticket types

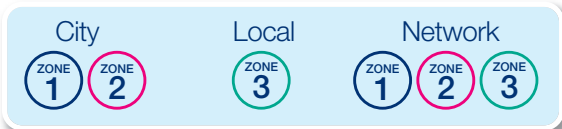
Why are these changes being made?

Currently these tickets operate on a network wide basis covering the whole of Greater Glasgow. As many of our customers make relatively short journeys within their own local area, the current structure of these tickets makes it difficult to offer consistent value for money, while, at the same time, ensuring that the price paid reflects the cost of travel involved.

With the new zonal structure that is being introduced from 25 October, customers will simply pick the zone or zones in which they require to travel. Network wide travel will continue to be available.

How will it work?

The zones that will apply from 25 October are based on the existing three zones used for the **FirstCard** range of tickets, with City, Local and Network options available.



The map overleaf shows these zones and their boundaries so you can select the best ticket for you.

Simply ask the driver for the ticket and zones you require when you board the bus ie. City **FirstDay**, Network **FirstDay** etc.

East Kilbride – Lanarkshire	Local
