Toryglen – Croftfoot

All journeys will be renumbered to operate as service 2.

In Rutherglen the route will be revised to operate from Toryglen via its current route to Main Street then via East Main Street, Fraser Avenue*, Hamilton Road*, Calderwood Road*, Dryburgh Road, Stonelaw Road and current route. From Croftfoot this revision of route will operate in reverse.

On the streets marked with an asterisk (*), service 2 will operate on 'hail and ride' basis and will pick up and set down passengers where it is safe to do so.

A revised timetable will be introduced but the frequency will be unchanged.

City Centre – Halfway

The Monday to Saturday daytime timetable will be revised to operate every 30 minutes. A new early morning journey will also operate from Halfway, Monday to Friday.

On Monday to Saturday evenings, Halfway, Newton, Westburn and Dukes Road will be served hourly by service 7 extending via Rutherglen to the city centre.

On Sundays service 7 will operate hourly between Cambuslang Terminus and the city centre via Dukes Road and Rutherglen. Early Sunday mornings and evenings, service 7 will operate between Rutherglen and the city centre.

Robroyston – Parkhall

The Monday to Saturday daytime frequency will be revised to operate every 30 minutes.

The evening service after around 7pm will operate hourly between Robroyston and West Regent Street only with the the section of route between the city centre and Clydebank being withdrawn.

On Sundays service 11 will operate 1/2 hourly during the day between Robroyston and City Centre with alternate buses extending to Clydebank.

Duntocher – Glasgow

This service will be revised to provide one return journey per day Monday to Friday and will be renumbered 40D (please note that the journey will now be included in the service 40 timetable). All bus stops will be observed.

Buchanan Bus Station – East Kilbride

These services will be revised mainly to operate between Buchanan bus station and East Kilbride via Killermont Street, Renfrew Street and Renfield Street then via the current route.

From East Kilbride services 18 and 18A will run via their current routes to Trongate then Glassford Street, Ingram Street, South Frederick Street, George Square, North Hanover Street and Killermont Street.

In the morning peak period, Monday to Friday, service 18C journeys will operate to Charing Cross via Trongate, Stockwell Street, Stockwell Place, Howard Street, Jamaica Street, Argyle Street, Hope Street and Bath Street terminating at the King's Theatre.

Please refer to service 23 for replacement journeys to Summerston.

Easterhouse – City Centre

Revised timetable introduced and coordinated with service 11 between the city centre and Provanmill to provide a joint 15 minutes service.

Drumchapel – East Kilbride

Revised timetable introduced.

Govan – City Centre – Summerston

A revised timetable will be introduced daily.

On Mondays to Fridays, the daytime frequency will be improved to every 10 minutes.

Alternate journeys Monday to Saturday daytime, and most Sunday and evening journeys will be extended from the city centre via Byres Road and Maryhill to Summerston to replace service 18.

The timetable of the service will be revised to operate every 60 minutes. Please see service 128 for details of additional journeys between High Possil and City Centre.

Milton – Castlemilk/East Kilbride

On Mondays to Fridays a revised timetable will be introduced.

31G

231

Service 31C will be revised to operate via its current route to Dougrie Road then right into Castlemilk Drive and left into Arden Craig Road to terminate at Mitchellhill. Return via right into Arden Craig Road right into Castlemilk Drive, Dougrie Road and current route.

Craigend – Parkhead

The frequency of this service will be improved to operate every 30 minutes.

The route will be revised to operate via its current route to Cumbernauld Road then via Edinburgh Road, Glencorse Street, Carntyne Road, Rigby Street, Shettleston Road and Duke Street.

Gartcosh – Parkhead

The route of service 33 will be revised to operate between Craigend, Mossvale Road and Parkhead. A revised timetable will be introduced operating every 30 minutes.

In Greenfield a revised route will be followed via Torphin Crescent, Inveresk Street, Eskbank Street, Duror Street and Hollowglen Road.

Govan – Castlemilk

Slightly revised timetable introduced although current frequency is unchanged.

In Castlemilk the route will be extended from its current terminus at Windlaw to Arden Craig Road at Carmunnock Road.

Glasgow – Abronhill

Journeys which currently terminate at Moodiesburn will be revised to terminate at Muirhead. Within Muirhead buses will operate via Lindsaybeg Road, Chryston Main Street and Cumbernauld Road.

Monday to Saturday daytime, the frequency will be revised to operate every 30 minutes.

Please see service X3 for alternative journeys between Moodiesburn and Muirhead.

Night bus journeys from Glasgow will be renumbered N36. Please note the Thursday night service will be withdrawn.

Easterhouse – City Centre

The route of service 39A will be revised to operate via its current route from Easterhouse to Alexandra Parade then Wishart Street, John Knox Street, Duke Street, George Street and via service 39 route. The return route will be in reverse.

A slightly revised timetable will be introduced with service 39 journeys being revised to operate off-peak Monday to Saturday only. Service 39A will operate at other times.

Clydebank – Easterhouse

A slightly revised timetable will be introduced Monday to Saturday.

City Centre – Easterhouse

A slightly revised timetable will be introduced Monday to Saturday.

Barlanark – Drumchapel/Antonine Park

Minor changes will be made to the timetable Monday to Friday.

Craigend – City Centre

The Monday to Saturday daytime frequency will be revised to operate every 30 minutes.

Eglesham/Newton Mearns – Knightswood

A revised timetable will be introduced daily.

Off peak Monday to Friday and Saturday daytime alternate journeys will start and terminate at Broomhill, Crow Road (TA Hall) rather than Knightswood.

During Monday to Fridays off-peak, two of the current four buses per hour on service 44A will start and terminate on Mearns Road at Waterfoot Road.

On Saturdays, service 44A will operate alternately 30 minutes from Newton Mearns and 30 minutes from Clarkston. Service 44 will continue to operate every 30 minutes from Eglesham.

A combined 10 minute service will continue to operate during the daytime Monday to Saturday between Clarkston Toll and Broomhill.

Auchinairn – Kennishead/Govan

A revised timetable will be introduced daily on service 45.

During Monday to Saturday daytime, a 10 minute frequency will be operated between Auchinairn and Thornliebank Station with four buses per hour continuing to Kennishead (service 45) and a 30 minute 45A service continuing via Thornliebank to Govan to replace service 47.

On Sundays a 60 minute service will operate on service 45A between the City Centre and Silverburn.

Between Ibrox and Govan, service 45A will operate via Helen Street, Edmiston Drive, Craigton Road, Crossloan Road, Harmony Road, Golspie Street and Govan Bus Station to provide a direct link between Drumoyne and ASDA.

With the exception of the peak period Monday to Friday when journeys will continue to start and finish at Claremont Street, all other journeys on service 57/57A will start and finish at Holland Street.

Renumbered to operate as service 27A from Kilsyth and 27B from Twechar via existing route to Glasgow. A revised timetable will also be introduced.

A slightly revised timetable will be introduced.

The morning and evening peak journeys extending from Waterside to Twechar will be withdrawn.

Glasgow – Harestanes

A revised timetable will be introduced daily.

The daytime frequency Monday to Saturday will be revised from 10 minutes to 15 minutes.

Inner Circle

A revised timetable will be introduced daily, but there will be no change to the frequency. The route of service 89 will be revised between Govan and Shawlands to operate as current route to Summertown Road then Copland Road, Edmiston Drive, Paisley Road West, Paisley Road, Seaward Street, Shields Road, St Andrew's Drive, Nithsdale Road and Darnley Road then current route.

Service 90 will operate via the above route in reverse but will continue to serve Kildrostan Street.

On Mondays to Saturdays the 5pm journey from Partick to Anniesland will extend to Drumchapel.

Parkhead and Cambuslang

Service 108 will be withdrawn and replaced by an additional service 308 journeys between Parkhead and Cambuslang and additional service 7 journeys between Halfway and Cambuslang.

The terminus at Parkhead will be moved from Nisbett Street to East Wellington Street.

The evening (after around 8pm) and Sunday timetable will be revised although the frequency will be unchanged.

Glasgow – Duntocher

On Sundays during the day, most journeys from Duntocher will terminate at Renfrew Street rather than Buchanan bus station.

Govan – Mount Florida

The daytime route Monday to Saturday will be revised to operate between Govan and Govanhill (Calder Street/Allison Street) and will operate via Paisley Road West, Old Govan Road and Lorne Street/Harvie Street.

An hourly service will operate during the daytime Monday to Saturday.

The evening and Sunday timetable is unchanged.
