Service 4 will continue to serve Bromley Heath, and now finish at Downend Customers living in the Bromley Heath Road area will continue to be served by Service 318/319 to Staple Hill and Kingswood. This service is being improved to offer an hourly evening and Sunday service between Kingswood and UWE. Customers wishing to travel south to Hanham would need to change to Service 6 at Kingswood.

			<p>Westerleigh Road to Downend, then along Badminton Road to join the existing route at Fouracre Road. This means that Blackhorse Road and Badminton Road between the Leap and Fouracre Road will no longer be served by Service X62, but both will continue to be served by Service 48.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Westerleigh Road will now be served by a change in route of Service X62 at peak times only. At other times, customers will need to walk to Beaufort Road for Service 49 or Downend Horseshoe for other services. There is a loss of direct links from Westerleigh Road to Frenchay, Staple Hill, Kingswood and Hanham. Customers would need to catch services at Downend Horseshoe. • Customers living in Westbourne Road will need to walk to bus stops on Badminton Road for Service 342 or 48, and on Beaufort Road for Service 48. • Customers who wish to travel south towards Staple Hill, Soundwell and Kingswood may still catch Services 318/319, which is being improved to offer an hourly evening and Sunday service between Kingswood and UWE • Customers wishing to travel south to Hanham would need to change to Service 6 at Kingswood.

	only)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The frequency of service 4 will be reduced to every 30 minutes at peak times. • Customers may still travel from Frenchay to Staple Hill and Kingswood on existing services 318/9, which is being improved to offer an evening and Sunday service between Kingswood and UWE • Customers wishing to travel to Hanham would need to use service 318/319 and change to service 6 at Kingswood • The current service 328 will be replaced with service 327, which travels to Yate Shopping Centre via Hambrook, Winterbourne (via Main Road) then Hicks Common - North Corner and Heather Avenue in Frampton Cotterell and Coalpit Heath.

The frequency of this service will be reduced to every 30 minutes at peak times. • Customers wishing to travel beyond Downend to Staple Hill, Kingswood and Hanham will need to change at Downend to use services 318/319 to Kingswood. • The current service 328 will be replaced with service 327, which travels to Yate shopping Centre via Hambrook, Winterbourne (via Main Road) then Hicks Common - North Corner and Heather Avenue in Frampton Cotterell and Coalpit Heath.
