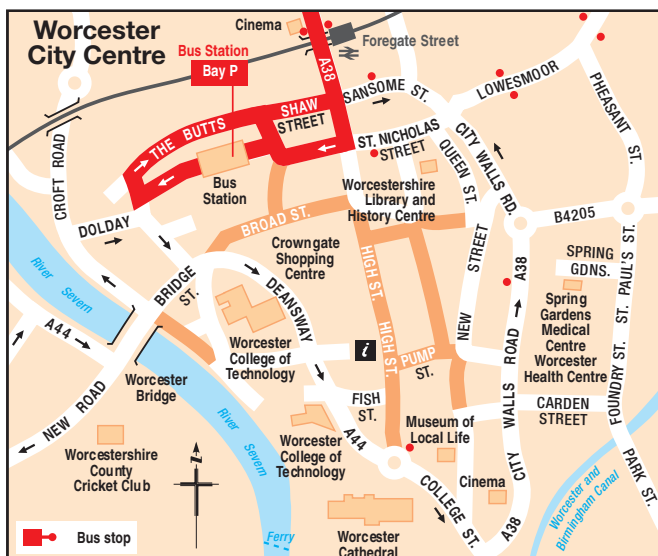

# Places of interest



## Worcester

An 11th-century cathedral city with a wealth of history.

The cathedral in its magnificent riverside setting provides a backdrop to a city that contrasts the half-timbered 'Tudor House' in Friar Street, the Commandery with its Great Hall and

the Guildhall with its elaborate facade, believed to be the finest example of early Georgian architecture in the country, with the 21st century Crowngate Development.



From the bus station a short escalator ride whisks us up into what is arguably one of the Midlands' most elegant shopping malls. Here you may browse at leisure or for the inquisitive a set of brass plaques at strategic locations puts you in the picture of 'Olde Worlde Worcester'.

Home to world famous Royal Worcester Spode and the Dyson Perrins Museum of fine porcelain, nearby the Commandery housed the Royalist Headquarters during the Battle of Worcester.

Take a leisurely journey down the river on one of the pleasure cruisers or search out one of the many cafes and bistros for an excellent lunch. Enjoy fine ales brewed on the premises at Worcester's very own brewery.

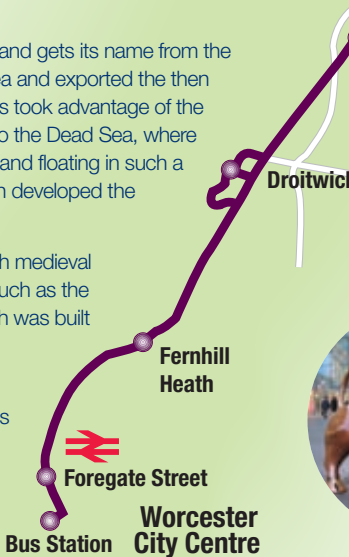

## Droitwich Spa

Droitwich literally means 'Place of Salt' and gets its name from the time that the Romans occupied the area and exported the then very valuable commodity. The Victorians took advantage of the natural brine; its strength second only to the Dead Sea, where muscular relief is derived by swimming and floating in such a dense, concentrated salt solution which developed the town into a fashionable spa.

The attractive town centre is dotted with medieval churches and half-timbered buildings such as the Raven Hotel in St. Andrews Street which was built during the reign of Elizabeth I.

The Heritage Centre in Victoria Square houses a museum which includes items from the Roman past, the history of salt and of more recent times its connection with radio broadcasting.



## Wychbold

Travelling further along towards Bromsgrove it is possible for visitors to spend many hours at Webbs of Wychbold, the Midlands biggest garden centre with its 50 acres of gardening, leisure and pleasure. It has something to suit all green fingers besides a gift shop and a restaurant, Webbs have been trading since the middle of the 19th century and were appointed suppliers to Queen Victoria and every Monarch since.

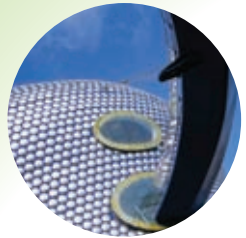
